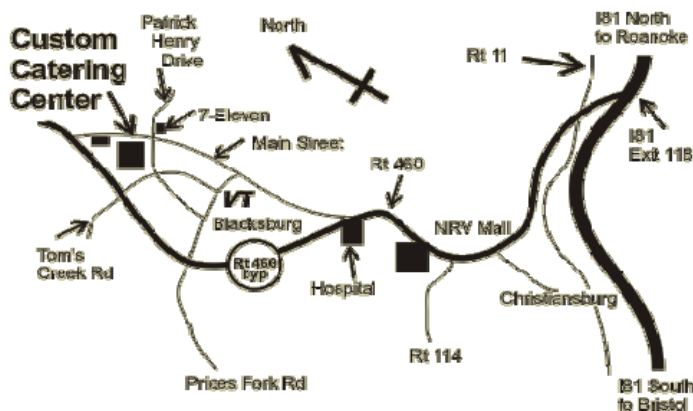
**"Let the Virginia Tech Industrial & Systems Engineering Dept
